


ARE YOU BEING TARGETED?

An estimated \$35 billion in cargo is stolen from the U.S. every year¹, and unsecured and unattended trailers are prime targets. You can often find these trailers at warehouses, distribution centers, and secured yards; which also tend to have a high volume of product stored on site. These locations are hotspots for cargo theft activity, and in recent years, have been ground zero for an estimated 35% of reported cargo thefts.

ANNUAL CARGO THEFT LOSS BY PRODUCT TYPE




